I hope that the BAA members appreciate the work that Richard Barras and Rohan Johnstone do behind the scenes as the associations Secretary and Treasurer.

I was sorry to hear that the World Cup to be contested in Canada this year has been cancelled. I was appalled to read the reasons why, which included that possible child molesters could be among attending boomerang throwers... I have written a letter to the Canadian newspapers in an attempt to put an Australian side to the ridiculous amount of reasons for not conducting this cup. The next International Tournament will now be held in Japan in '94, so I hope that finally Japan hosts a World Cup as they have been promising this event for some years now.

Back to the local front, and I'm looking forward to meeting some of our Western Australian throwers at this years Nationals in Perth. **THROWING INSTRUCTIONS**

An Aboriginal legend from Northern Australia informs us that "All things were created in the Dreamtime when Kunapippi, the mother of tribes, came out of the north-west with her band of left-handed boomerang throwers'. Therefore, these instructions are written for people still throwing left-handed as the Creator intended. If you have fallen into a state of right-handedness, you will need to refer to the note (\*) at the end of these instructions.

1. To throw successfully, you will need:-

- 1.1 a boomerang correctly shaped to return. You have now obtained one of these instructions .
- 1.2 A calm day with a faint breeze at most. With experience you will cope with light breezes.
- 1.3 An area clear of obstacles which may damage your boomerang, and clear of people until you have learnt to throw in a controlled manner.

2. Throw by referring to the diagrams and:-

- 2.1 Keeping the flat side of the boomerang against your fingers, grip it either;
  - 2.1.1 In your lightly closed fist, or,
  - 2.1.2 Like a pencil, or,
  - 2.1.3 Pinched between thumb and forefinger. You may obtain most spin this way.
- 2.2 Aiming almost 90 degrees to the left of any breeze (\*) and slightly above horizontal, 15 degrees at most.
- 2.3 Keeping the boomerang leaning just left (\*) of vertical as it leaves your hand - between 11 and 12 o'clock. (\*)

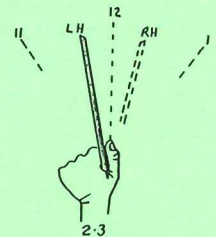
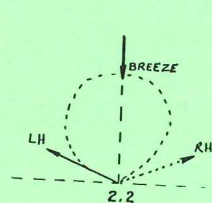
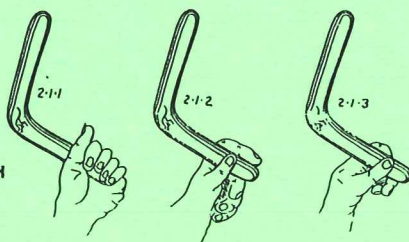
- 2.4 Taking a step and throwing straight at your aim point with a wristy throw that makes the boomerang spin through the air.
- 2.5 Experiment with slight changes to the angle to the breeze, the angle to the vertical and the amount of spin until you have the boomerang returning accurately.

\* Right handers need a right handed boomerang and throw to the right of the breeze with the boomerang leaning between 12 and 1 o'clock. All other instructions apply as above.

NOTE: By using a back-handed action, it is possible to throw a left handed boomerang right handed, and vice versa.

## HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SIX WEEK SUPER SERIES 92

The trend for bad weather during the Super Series started during the first competition. Perfect weather, the day before whilst marking the lines out on the oval - then the next day when the comp. is on - very strong winds await the throwers... The winds on this day were more than 40 knots, but with Kempy travelling more than 130 kilometres to compete - we decided to continue with the planned competition.... Main highlights - Kempy winning the MTA with a massive time of 4:05 seconds - he was the only competitor to take a catch. Fast Catch - Rob Croll run away winner with 2 catches.....

Our 2nd comp was held at Namara Primary School in Waverley, in excellent conditions..... The highlight was the MTA event which was won by Andrew Travis with a time of 44 seconds... Croll was 2nd with 39 seconds and Carter was 3rd with 36 seconds... Rob Croll was the overall winner again this day from Carter, with Brett Doyle from Barooga 3rd.....

Our 3rd competition was held at Point Cook - 25 kilometres west of Melbourne in terrible windy conditions.... Carter won the MTA with the time of 8.6 seconds and Doubling with 3 catches.... The only decent times or scores recorded this day were Croll in the Fast Catch - 33.2 seconds and Carter in Aussie Round - 65 points..... Carter was the Overall winner this comp from Croll, with Travis in 3rd place..... In Accuracy Craig Carter (5 years old) had his first placing in a comp - he finished 2nd with 15 points, 2 points behind the winner.....

So on we ventured to our next venue, a week later, at the picturesque Westgate Park, at the base of the Westgate Bridge, a short distance from the heart of Melbourne..... Things were going as normal - strong winds awaiting the throwers and a heavy rain storm on its way.... Unfortunately the comp was closed before all events were conducted..... Rob was the winner of Aussie Round, and Fast Catch, Carter won Accuracy and Trick Catching was divided with Rob and Bruce each taking 3 catches in strong winds which were gusting up to 30 knots..... The throwers departed with still 2 events to be conducted - Doubling and MTA, so after this day we were ready for the 5th leg of the "Super Series" the Victorian Titles... Dennis deservedly won the overall by half a point, but not without a strong challenge from Rob Croll in windy conditions, on a very wet oval.... Main highlights of the day were - Colin Foley in his first ever competition - competing in Rubber Boots. The strong wind really made good scores hard to come by as was proven by Rob winning the MTA event with a time of under 10 seconds and Bruce Carter winning the Aussie Round with 38 points... Dennis did extremely well winning the Doubling and Trick Catching events.....so next week was to be the final comp of our Super Series at Werribee....

For this final comp, the weather was excellent with wind gusts only reaching 5 knots at times.... Scores were good, with Rob Croll showing great skills. He scored heavily in Aussie Round and Accuracy with 83 and 43 points respec-

tively and won the MTA with a time of 27.3 seconds - He also did a time of 46.68 seconds in MTA but the boom was caught a short distance outside the 50 metre line... Colin Foley in his 2nd comp, was equal winner of the Doubling event and Robbie took 8 catches in winning the Trick Catching event.

At the completion of the 6 week competition - each thrower had their 4 best results in each event averaged out.

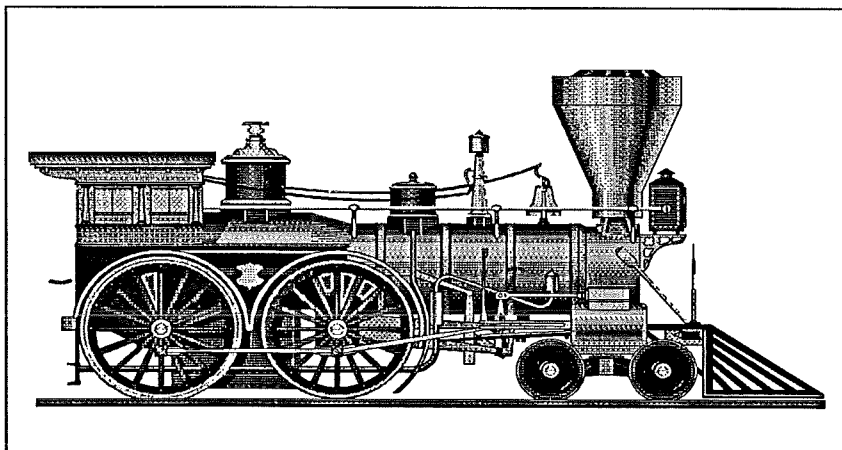

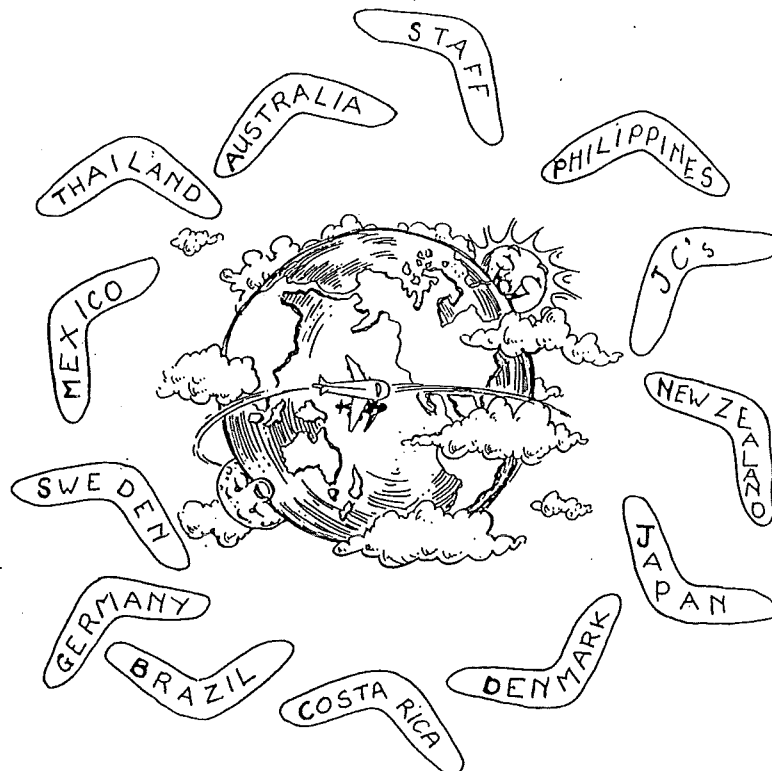
