





Unfortunately due to a change in school holidays in Perth, we have been forced to change the dates for the Championships.

We are now well on the way to getting the show on the road as the following information will reveal.

Sponsorship to date

Rangs Boomerangs

Burswood - The Burswood is the venue for the indoor Matchplay. They have agreed to let us stage the event there for

free and to assist us with lighting, sound and flooring etc.

Snap Print - Snap are our print sponsors and will handle all our printing requirements.

Creative Native - We negotiating to have a dance group perform at the Matchplay opening and a private performance for our

group during the week.

We are talking to various companies seeking major sponsorship and are hopeful of achieving the required funds necessary to stage the championships.

Accommodation and Transport

We have available accommodation for all competitors and officials, plus we have arranged a spectators hotel only 5 minutes from the City. The accommodation cost is \$22.00 per night per person. The hotels offers all our requirements including a function area and most importantly two large boomerang fields just across the road from the hotel.

Arrangements for transport are being negotiated with a reduction in hire car charges for competitors and spectators while in Perth. A large bus will be organised to ferry competitors to and from events. Airport pickup can also be arranged for all visitors if required. A package of all details for accommodation and transport has been sent to each President or Secretary throughout the world so you can contact your local club official for further information.

Please let your club know if you are interested in coming to Perth so we can get a feel for how many people we can expect to come. Don't organise you air tickets yet as I will be talking to airlines to try and arrange discounts for all visitors to the championships. I will advise all clubs and officials on arrangements for airline bookings before December.

World Matchplay Details

The Matchplay format has been set along the following guidelines.

- * Total Competitors 16
- * 12 Competitors chosen. The last 4 places will be determined by trials the day before the competition and is open to any club registered member worldwide.
- * Registration fee for Matchplay \$100
- * Prize money \$15,000 total. Broken down from \$4,000 for 1st place to \$300 for 16th place.
- * The Matchplay is to be the start of what we expect to be the professional aspect of boomerang throwing. Details on the events and other related information will follow. It promises to be an exciting event that will capture the imagination of the World. We already have two film segments which were shown on Australia Wide TV which we have on video if anyone should require.

If you require any further information on the Matchplay or have any ideas to improve the competition please let me know. Being the first event of its kind, we all need to pull together to ensure a great success.

Exciting news is the amount of countries that look like competing in the Championship. The field so far is USA, Australia, Belgium, France, Germany, Japan, Switzerland, Canada and Italy. We will probably have to put a limit of 11 teams total for the International Cup to suit our timetable of events.

The organisation of the Championship has proved a massive task any many people in Perth are helping us organise the program. What we need now is for all people interested in the Championship to let us know so we have a rough idea how many folks we should cater for. Just keep in touch with myself or Steve Pankhurst.
